**SPECIAL CONDITION DURING EXECUTION OF WORK INSIDE OPERATIONAL AREA**

- 1) Obstruction Lights every 3m, shall be provided for indicating the area as Work Site during Low Visibility & Night Hours.
- 2) Work area to be barricaded by Safety Ribbons & Safety Cones. In Works, where Excavation is involved, Work area shall be barricaded with Water Filled Barriers.
- 3) All Vehicles to be provided with Obstruction Flags and Strobe Lights.
- 4) Contractor shall arrange Transport for Labours & Staff from Entry Gate to Work Site & Back.
- 5) No Airside Driving Permit shall be issued unless the Driver has completed & passed the Airside Drivers Course.
- 6) Contractor shall be subject to penalty system imposed by MIAL in case breach of safety rules.
